AIM OF THE COURSE:

1. Ensure all instructor candidates are very familiar with all material
2. Revise lecturing techniques
3. Revise/teach small group teaching techniques
4. Familiarize instructor candidates with administrative process for running courses

DESIGN OF THE COURSE

This course composes of" Pre-course reading and completion of pre-course multiple choice questions before attending the course, lectures and skill stations. This is to ensure that they are familiar with what the participants are being taught.

PRE-COURSE READING

It is essential that all instructor candidates read the course manual prior to attending the course and complete the pre-course MCQs.

SKILL STATIONS

Each instructor candidate should be allocated at least one skill station to teach. He/she will teach this to other instructor candidates, who will role-play the part of trainees. An experienced instructor, who has had experience of teaching that skill station, will provide feedback and tips. Again, instructor candidates must have the opportunity to see ALL skill stations.

CLASS SIZE

The class size is between 10 to 12 candidates.

AWARD OF CERTIFICATE

Certificate will be issued to those who have completed all parts of the course and successfully passed all the course assessment by local institution.

LECTURES

Each instructor candidate should have been allocated at least one lecture to prepare and give. A trained external instructor should be allocated to give feedback, along with the audience of other instructor candidates. As it is the combined instructor-provider course not all lectures need to be covered during the instructor component as the instructor candidates will have the opportunity to hear the lectures during the provider component.

The qualified external instructor who provides feedback must have given the lectures he/she is allocated him/herself in order to provide insightful help.

ASSESSMENT

Post course MCQs

There are 30 post course multiple choice questions to test the instructor candidates' knowledge of the course material. The passing mark is expected to score at least 70%
