Conference Highlights

The 20th ECCC was organized for three days from 10 to 12 May at the Event Centre, InterContinental Hotel, Dubai Festival City, Dubai, UAE.

The conference received a total of **1928 participants**, coming from **75 countries** and endorsement from **40 societies and federations** along with **8 media partners**.

A total of **305** faculty members participated, of which **144** were **international speakers**, **70 regional speakers** and **91 local speakers**, who made their invaluable contribution towards a strong scientific program.

The **3-day** scientific program included **5 tracks** covering **410 lecture topics** including the following subspecialty tracks within **61 sessions**.

- **3** Critical Care tracks each day
- **1** Global Network of Emergency Medicine (GNEM) track
- **1** Neuro-critical Care Track
- **2** Nursing Tracks each day

The overall program also covered the following Courses and Workshops, which were held in parallel to the main program.

The opening ceremony started with the recitation of verses from the Holy Quran by **Mr. Ahmad Al Ahdal**.

Distinguished **Prof. Jorge Hidalgo**, President of the World Federation of Intensive and Critical Care (WFICC) from Belize City, delivered the welcome speech. He emphasized the critical role that conferences like ECCC play in education and the advancement of the medical field, as well as the importance of international collaborations.

Later on, **Dr. Amelia Latu Tuipulotu**, Chief Nursing Officer Director from World Health Organization (WHO), Geneva-Switzerland, gave a speech focusing on the importance of international solidarity in the face of global health risks; praising ECCC's diversified attendees and faculty.

Following that, **Dr. Sumaya Al Blooshi**, President of the Emirates Nursing Association (ENA) and Director of the Nursing Department at Emirates Health Services (EHS), took the stage. She congratulated the ECCC committee on their 20-years achievement and emphasized the crucial role of nurses in the critical care department.

Concluding all the speeches, **Assoc. Prof. Dr. Hussain Al Rahma**, Chairperson of the conference welcomed the delegates and faculty to this edition of ECCC, wished them a fruitful and rich participation and also thanked the sponsors and exhibitors for their participation. Moreover, he reminisced on 20 years of ECCC with all the accomplishments and milestones along the way.

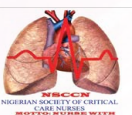

The scientific program covered **14 halls** each day providing parallel tracks of scientific sessions program along with courses and workshops.

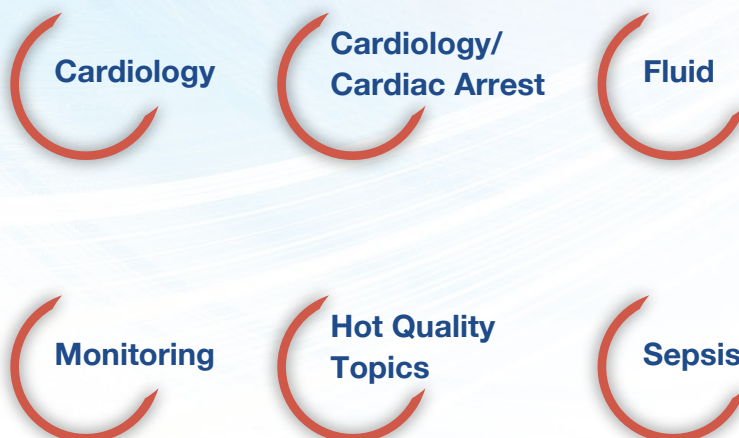

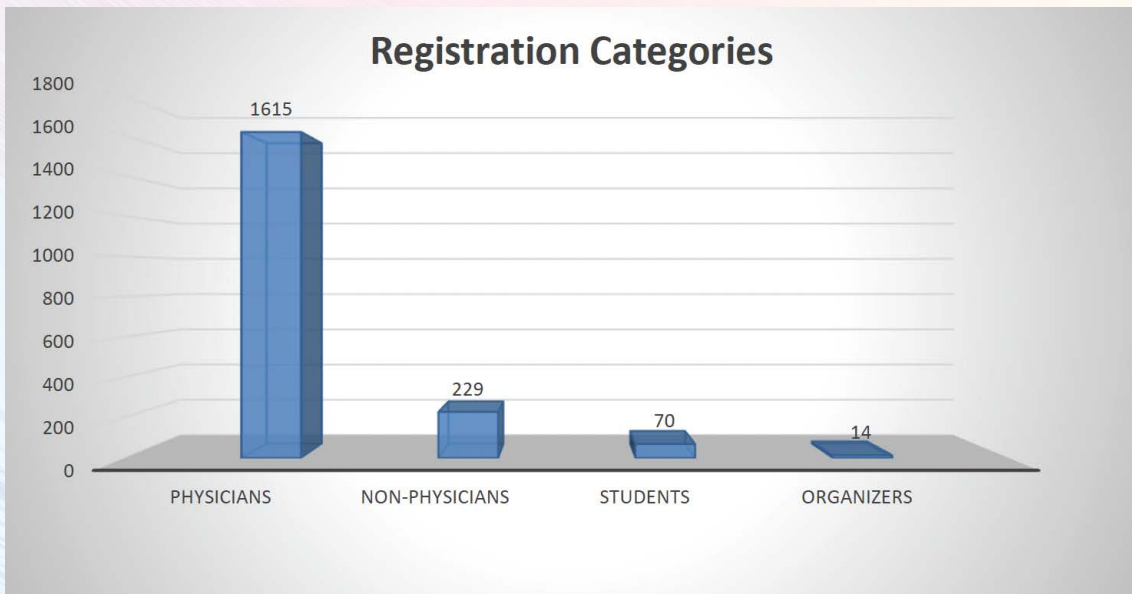

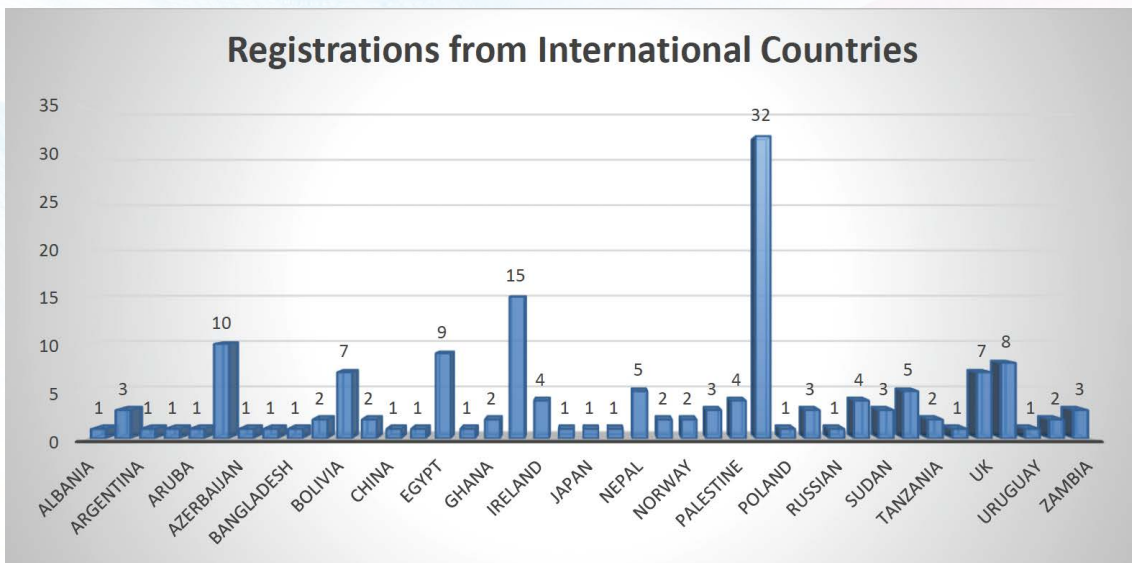

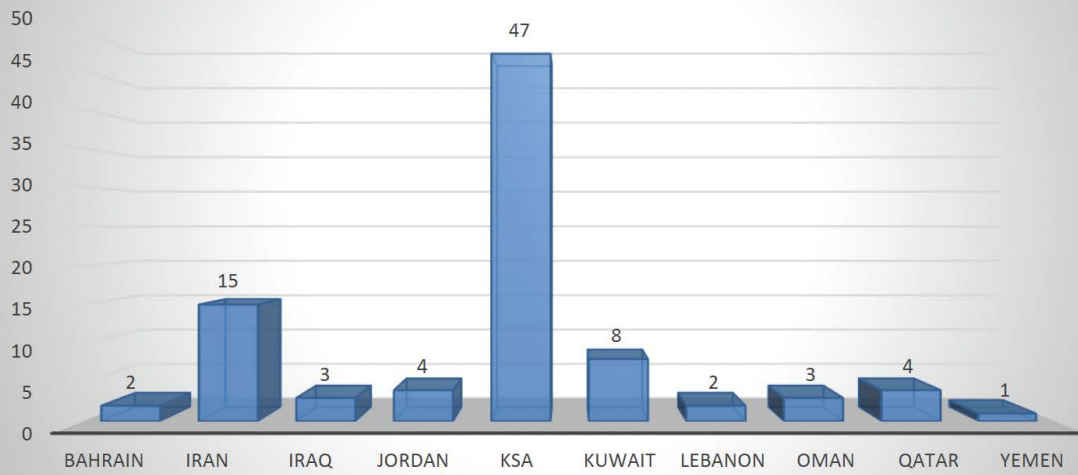

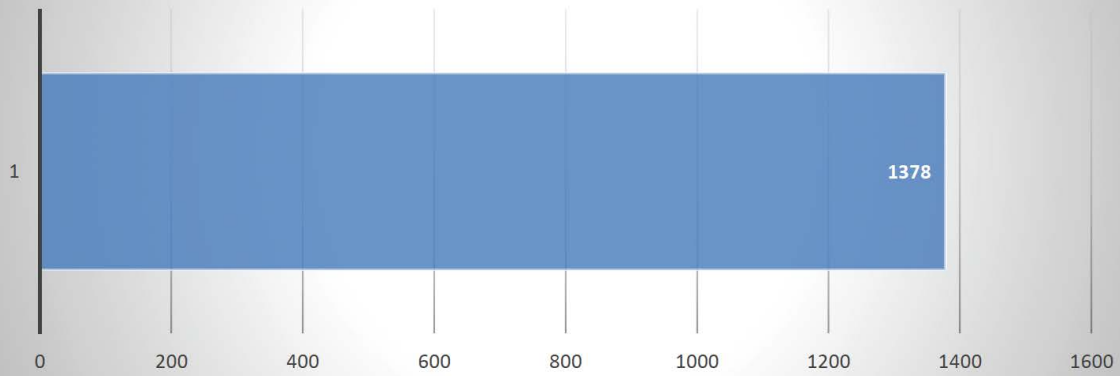
Registration Overview by Region



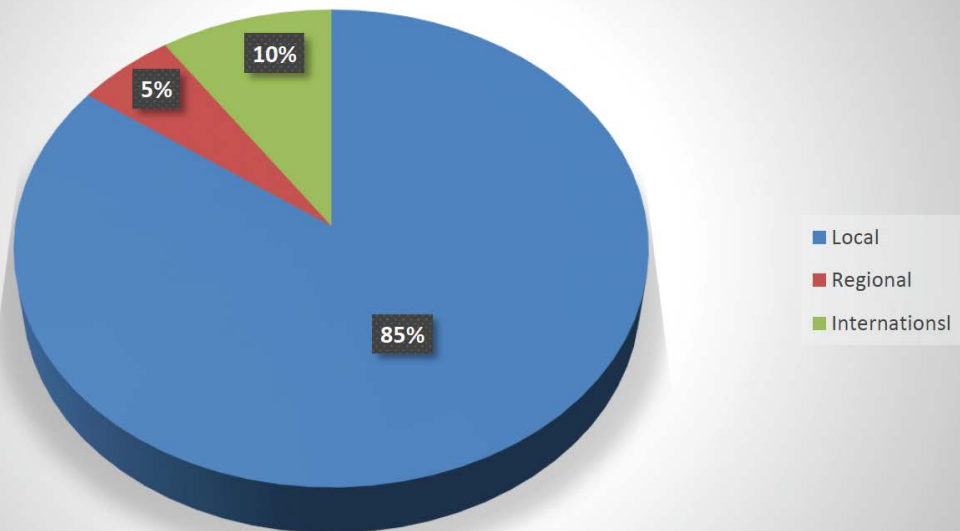
Registrations from Regional Countries

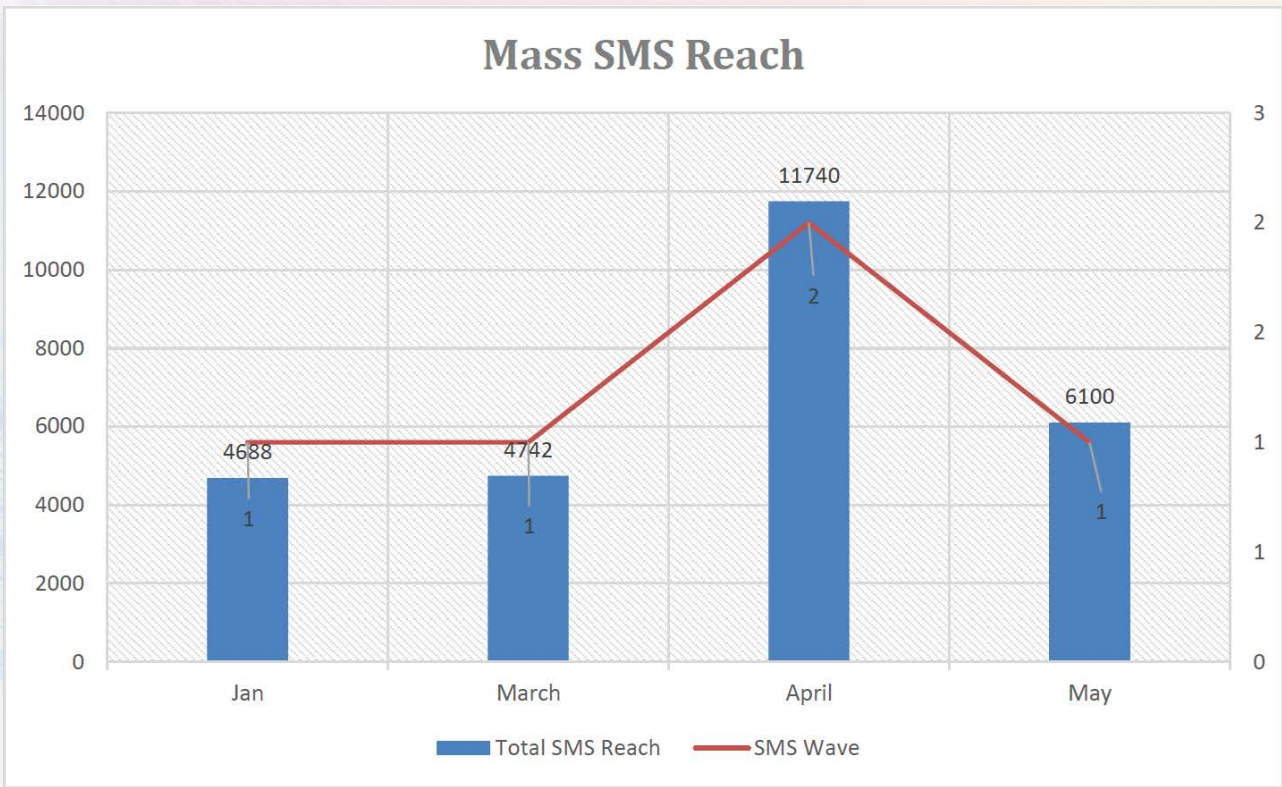

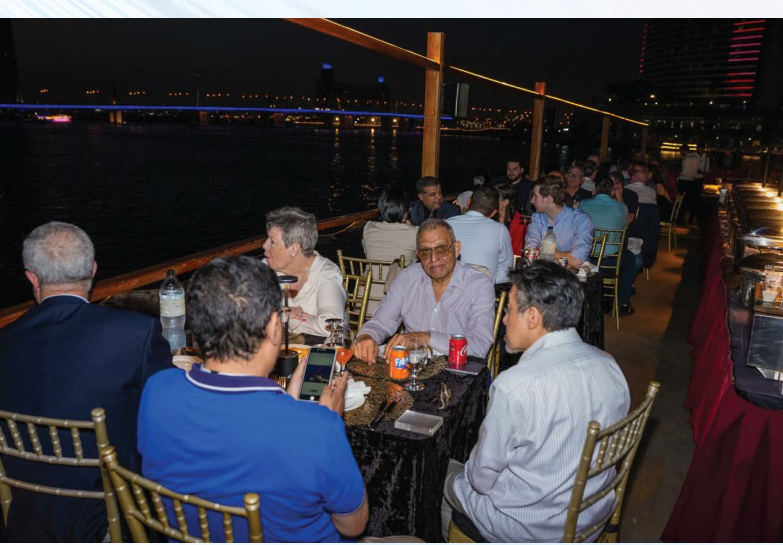
This deck offers a 360-degree view of Dubai's skyline, desert, and the Persian Gulf.
